



Revision Surgery





A lot has been learned since weight loss surgery became prominent. Many people who had surgery earlier on have had unexpected complications, and have had to have a revision procedure in order to fix the problems that arose from an old procedure.

Thankfully, doctors now know more about bariatric procedures, so revision is becoming increasingly less necessary.

The two most prominent forms of revision surgery are Lap Band to Sleeve and Sleeve to Bypass.

The procedures are as they are named: the lap band to sleeve is the adjustment of a lap band procedure to a gastric sleeve, and the sleeve to bypass is a revision of a gastric sleeve to a bypass.
